WOOL CRAFT CLASSES SCHEDULE



As the Cotswold sheep was historically bred for its amazing wool, the Society would like to introduce craft classes into the Summer Show schedule.

The importance of wool and its characteristics are again being recognised by modern society as a valuable, renewable and eco-friendly fibre.

The classes have been announced prior to the sheep showing schedule, which will be circulated with the next newsletter in mid-June, to allow entrants maximum time for preparation.

The classes are an opportunity to explore and enjoy Cotswold wool and create both beautiful and useful items.

2021 WOOL CRAFT CLASS RULES:

- The classes are open to all members and friends.
- Classes are free to enter.
- Multiple entries are allowed in each class and enter as many classes as you like.
- The classes will be split into ADULTS or JUNIORS (juniors under 16 years old on show day).
- Items can be brought with you on the day of the show, if allowed, in line with Government guidelines.

- Prizes will be awarded in all categories; all entries will also receive a Society prize.
- The Best in Show item will be awarded the Wool Cup

2021 WOOL CRAFT CLASS SCHEDULE:

1. **Household Items**

Large or small, Cotswold wool can be used in conjunction with other materials to produce a finished item.

2. **Decorative Items**

Any item used for decorative purposes, if the item is eligible for the household class it may be entered in both classes; for example, a picture or table mat.

3. **Clothing**

Wool can be used in conjunction with other materials to produce a finished garment or accessory.

4. **Garden, Outdoor Items**

Wool can be used with other materials, products this class would incorporate DIY items.
