WEAVING WEEKEND

25th and 26th JUNE 2022

A unique opportunity to attend a two-day workshop run by Jane Meredith in the heart of the Cotswolds. Jane has a lifetime's experience in wool craft and weaving. Colour is her passion. She lives in Herefordshire but has agreed to come to the Cotswolds to run a weaving workshop using Peglooms and the brilliantly easy to use Brinkley looms. The course will be held in a barn on my beautiful little farm located in a hidden valley near Stow on the Wold.

Cost: Early bird bookings £180 per person if you book before 1st May. £200 after 1st May.

Looms and all materials are provided including wool dyed naturally with plants from Jane's garden and a range of naturally coloured rare breed fleeces

A simple lunch will be served along with coffee, teas and snacks on both days.

Day One - Saturday 25th June 2022 - 10am-4pm

Peg-loom weaving



You will learn to card and tease out fleece and weave a peg loom mat or hanging using plant dyed wool and a range of naturally coloured fleece.

Weaving on a pegloom is a simple and effective to use different fleeces with all their diversity to make something beautiful. By the end of the first day you will have designed and woven a wall hanging or seat mat to take home with you.



Day Two - Sunday 26th June 2022 - 10am to 4pm

Brinkley loom weaving



Jane will show you how to use a Brinkley loom. It will take less than ten minutes to warp your loom up. Then she will show you how to weave a piece of fabric, perhaps a scarf, with yarn and fleece. Simple but so effective.... meditative but also fun!

At the end of the two days, you should have two or three samples to take home with you, and a very good over all knowledge of the process of using wool from the sheared fleece to the finished products.
