- b) To ensure that we order an adequate number of ear tags for your registerable lambs. We place one bulk order for ear tags each year and so that your flock number can be included in our order, we **must** have your tupping census information by 30th April. Otherwise, you may find that there are no ear tags available for your flock number.
