Entries in the Ram, Shearling Ram, Ewe and Shearling Ewe classes must be registered in the Flock Book and must wear the Society Registration Tag. Ram lamb and ewe lamb entries must be eligible for registration and wear EID management tags. All sheep, other than lambs, to have been shorn bare on or after 1st January 206 and before the Show, apart from Class 6; recently shorn animals are welcome in all classes.

In addition, all movement and tagging requirements must conform to the current DEFRA regulations.
