CONDITIONS OF ENTRY & RULES

RAM SALES: the following restrictions will apply:

- Senior Rams – No Restriction
- Shearling Rams – No Restriction in entering ONE, but for every additional Shearling Ram entry, there must also be two females of any age entered.
- Ram Lambs – No Restriction in entering ONE, but for every additional Ram Lamb entry, there must also be two females of any age entered.
- **Also note** that a combination of Shearling Ram & Ram Lamb will also trigger the requirement for two females to be entered.

McCartneys

1. Vendors may deliver Sheep on Friday 7th August from 4.00-6.00pm or on Saturday 8th August by 9.00am.
2. Entry Fees £10.00 plus VAT (£12.00) per Sheep, to include straw. Entry fees are collected to subsidise the printing of the sale catalogue – once catalogue is printed the entry fee is forfeited if the animal is then withdrawn.
3. All pedigree registered sheep will be sold in Guineas (£1.05), and in catalogue order. The auctioneers to charge a commission of 5.2%.
4. Cleansing facilities for vehicles and trailers will be available on site for a nominal charge.
5. It is the vendor's and purchaser's responsibility to ensure that all DEFRA rules and regulations are adhered to, with regard to movement of sheep at the time.
6. Food will be available all day on Saturday, 8th August in the canteen.
7. Vendors should ensure that their sheep are identified with the auctioneer's lot number tags as soon as possible to aid both the inspectors and potential purchasers.
8. ALL SHEEP SOLD, MUST BE SOLD IN THE SALE RING OR THROUGH THE AUCTIONEER'S OFFICE
9. A transfer fee of £5 per sheep will be charged to the purchaser at time of invoice.
